

Capturing Legible Fingerprints


Proper Capture of Image within Fingerprint Block



INCORRECT

Image printed too low in block.


Image protrudes into neighboring fingerprint block.



CORRECT


Entire image printed in the center of the block.

Proper Orientation of Rolled Fingerprint Impressions



INCORRECT


Image captured at an angle.




CORRECT

Capture image in a vertical upright position.

Proper Capture of Plain Fingerprint Impressions





White Lines/Cracks/Worn Ridges within Fingerprint Pattern Area



INCORRECT

Indicates dry, rough skin. Fingerprint ridge detail not visible.




CORRECT

Worn ridge detail may be improved with the following:

- 1) Ridge Builder
- 2) Corn Huskers Lotion
- 3) Lotion containing Aloe Vera
- 4) Massage finger to force blood to fingertips

Roll Fingerprints Nail to Nail



from the subject.3) Ensure entire first joint of the finger is in constant contact with the card.

Complete Pattern Area Not Present in Rolled Impressions





Complete Pattern Area Not Present in Plain Impressions




Non Discernable Images/Smudges





- 1) Do not apply excessive ink to the fingertip.
- 2) Do not apply excessive pressure to the fingertip.
- 3) During capture, turn subject's wrist and simply guide the finger being printed.

Multiple Images



Do not record multiple fingerprint images in a single fingerprint block.
